Telemed or face-to-face visits

Ability to pay does not affect ability to receive services. We accept most insurance plans and offer a sliding-scale fee with payments as low as \$5. Each client is scheduled for an initial assessment by a master's-level therapist, who evaluates need and may refer for:



Therapy

Individual, group and family therapy, using evidence-based practices.



Care Facilitation & Skills Training

Youth and families get access to resources; youth learn healthy life skills.



Psychiatric Services

Doctors complete evaluations, prescribe medications and answer questions.
